Although often categorised as one of the founding fathers of the punk era, they were simply interested in playing loud, fast, in your face Rock 'n' Roll rather than bad mouthing the Queen or fermenting anarchy. The Members, formed in the summer of 1977, were among the first to successfully blend reggae rhythms with punk's attitude and aggression.
