Featuring Steve Walwyn on guitar (now a mainstay of Dr Feelgood), Simon "Honeyboy" Hickling on vocals and harmonica, Craig Rhind on bass and "Cheeky" Chas Chaplin on drums, the band backed Steve Marriott for 2 years, making an album with him and 2 albums as The DTs. For many people this is the ultimate rock/blues line up and is unlikely ever to be bettered. This is rumoured to be the last ever appearance by the band, so make sure you buy well in advance as this will almost certainly be a sell-out.
